



## HOW THE GOVERNMENT CAN CONTRIBUTE



Enact Health policy and legislation to remove all user fee for pregnant women and under-5 children



Support with the provision of Rapid HIV Test Kits (RTK) and Asante Rapid Test Kits for recent infection.



Engage more healthcare workers of different cadre especially the hard-to-reach areas.



Commit at least 0.5% of state revenue to fund HIV program and promote Government-led ownership and coordination of ingenious health programs that will improve the health of state residents through Ministries, Departments, and Agencies.
